I-89 Lamoille River Bridges Stage 3 Traffic Switch

August 29, 2016 – Press Release

Milton, VT – Tetra Tech Construction is nearing completion of Stage 3 Construction on the I-89 Lamoille River bridges replacement project in Milton, Vermont, which will include shifting the existing northbound travel lanes from the median Stage 1 Bridge onto the newly constructed Stage 3 Bridge. To facilitate this work, a rolling roadblock will be performed throughout the work zone during this time. A rolling roadblock is a traffic control technique to significantly slow down traffic to a minimum of 20 mph in order to facilitate such work operations for short durations. The exact dates of this shift will be weather-dependent, but it is expected to occur on **August 31, 2016 or September 1, 2016**. Southbound traffic will remain in its current alignment on the existing southbound bridge structure until the completion of Stage 4. Following the completion of Stage 4 the northbound and southbound traffic will be shifted into their final alignment.

The Project Team asks the travelling public to help keep workers safe by reducing speeds through the active work zone and to stay alert for changing conditions. Additional speed enforcement will be present in the construction zone, and drivers are to be reminded that it is now against the law to use a handheld cell phone in construction work zones.
